Student Seminar by Department of History

A student seminar entitled Historiographical Debates: Aspects and Perspectives was held in offline mode on 1st December 2025. In which three students of the 5th Semester Major Course namely: Rana Ghosh, Riya Santra and Anusri Dalui presented their papers. The paper presented by Rana Ghosh was on the Causes of the French Revolution. Riya's paper dealt with the Rise of Napoleon. Anusri presented an analytical perspective of the Gupta Age in ancient Indian History. All the papers were well researched and paved the way for further intellectual churning and ignited an energetic response from faculty members as well as students.



Student Seminar by Department of Bengali

A Student Seminar was organised by the Department of Bengali, under the aegis of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), on 2nd December 2025 at 12:45 PM in Room No. 23 of the college. The seminar aimed to encourage academic engagement, critical thinking, and research-oriented learning among students of the Department of Bengali. The presentations included discussions on the dramatic characteristics of *Tiner Taloar Choritro*, the rise and fall of National Theatre, Rabindranath Tagore's experimental poetry, Dinabandhu Mitra's *Nil Darpan*, Bankimchandra Chattopadhyay's social thought, and the tragic elements in Shakespeare's plays. The presenters were Bristi Samantha, Soumi Ghorui, Rima Singh, Sumaiya Khatun, Keya Maity, and Supriti Dwari. The programme successfully enhanced students' presentation skills, subject knowledge, and confidence in academic discourse.



Student Seminar by Department of Political Science

The Department of Political Science, Purash Kanpur Haridas Nandi Mahavidyalaya, successfully organized a Student Seminar on 2nd December, 2025 at 12.45pm on the topic “Power, Authority and Sovereignty”. The seminar aimed to enhance academic engagement among students and provide them with a platform to articulate their understanding of key political concepts essential to the study of Political Science. The programme commenced with a brief introductory address by the Head of the Department, who highlighted the significance of the seminar topic within the broader framework of political theory topic. The topic was thematically dealt with by Megha Malik, Palashi Roy, Tusi Pal and Rupkatha Pal from semester 1. The students on the dias further elaborated on their presentations on the said topic. It strengthened students’ confidence, improved their research and presentation abilities, and deepened their understanding of fundamental political concepts.



Career Planning Seminar

Workshop on Understanding Geological Maps by Geography Students

A practical workshop titled “Understanding Geological Maps” was organized by the Students of Department of Geography on 12th December, 2025 at 2.45pm on understanding Geological Maps, with the objective of strengthening students’ understanding of geological map interpretation through peer-assisted learning. The workshop aimed to provide hands-on exposure to key concepts such as dip direction and dip calculation, which are essential for geological and geographical analysis. During the workshop, Soumya Kunti and Trisha Ghosh, students of Semester V, actively demonstrated the concepts of dip direction and dip calculation using geological maps for the benefit of Semester III students. The senior students explained the theoretical background of dip and strike, followed by step-by-step practical methods to determine dip direction from contour patterns and to calculate dip values from geological map sheets. This peer-led approach enhanced conceptual clarity and encouraged collaborative learning.



Alumni Meet

The Department of Bengali successfully organized an Alumni Meet on 14th December 2025 at 12:00 noon with the objective of strengthening the bond between the department and its alumni and fostering meaningful academic and professional interaction. 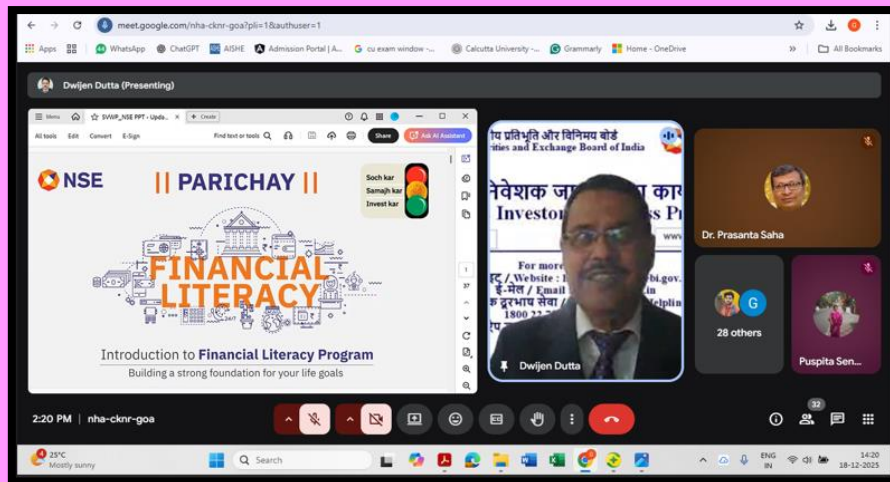
