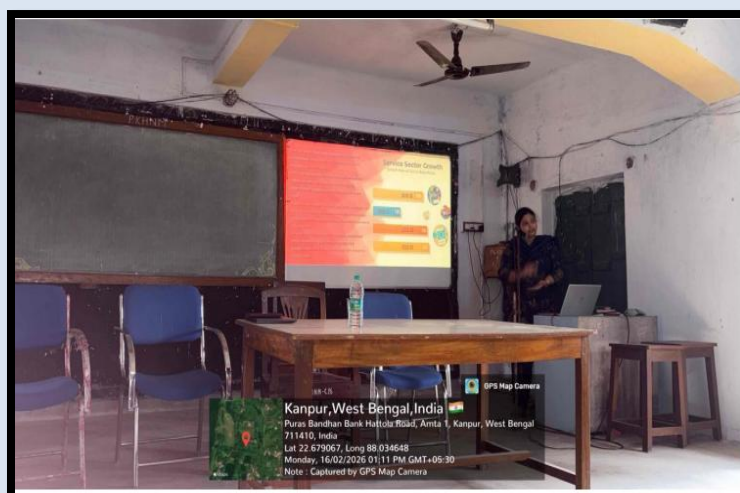
Placement Drive 2026 by Absolute Barbecues

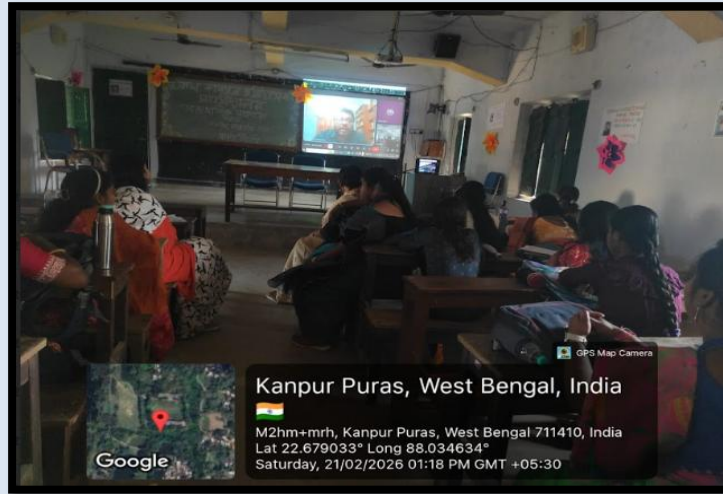
Invited Lecture Organized by the Department of Economics

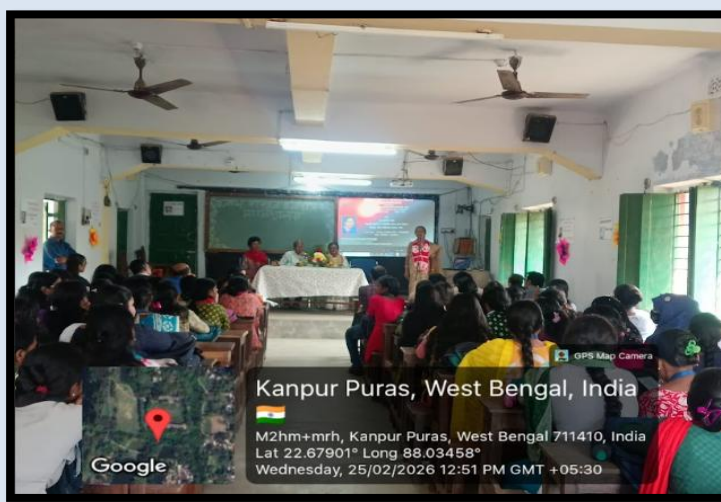
Invited Lecture organised by Department of Commerce
