Special Lecture Organized by the Department of History

The Department of History of Purash Kanpur Haridas Nandi Mahavidyalaya, in collaboration with the Department of History, Dr. Kanailal Bhattacharyya College, and under the aegis of the IQACs of both institutions, organized a Special Lecture on 2 June 2026. The keynote lecture was delivered by Dr. Bidusi Haldar (Sardar), Head, Department of History, Dr. Kanailal Bhattacharyya College, on the topic "উনবিংশ শতাব্দীতে সাধারণ স্বাস্থ্য বনাম নারী স্বাস্থ্য: একটি পর্যালোচনা" (*General Health versus Women's Health in the Nineteenth Century: A Review*). The speaker commenced her speech by portraying different facets of indigenous medicinal system practiced in Ancient and Medieval India. From there she moved to the realm of colonial health apparatus and causes behind the introduction of Allopathic medicine in India. She concluded the talk by highlighting the social challenges faced by Indian female health workers such as Dr. Kadambini Ganguly- the first female student in the Calcutta Medical College. Throughout her talk she engaged with the students and solved their queries with patience.



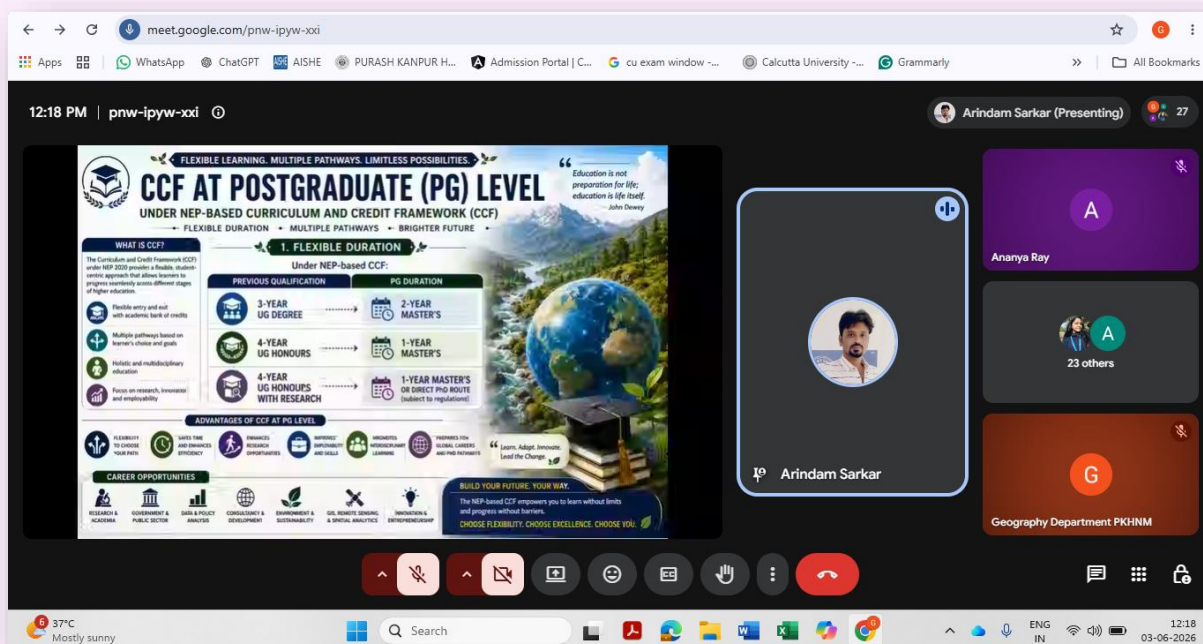
Teacher–Student Meeting on Transitioning to the 4th Year

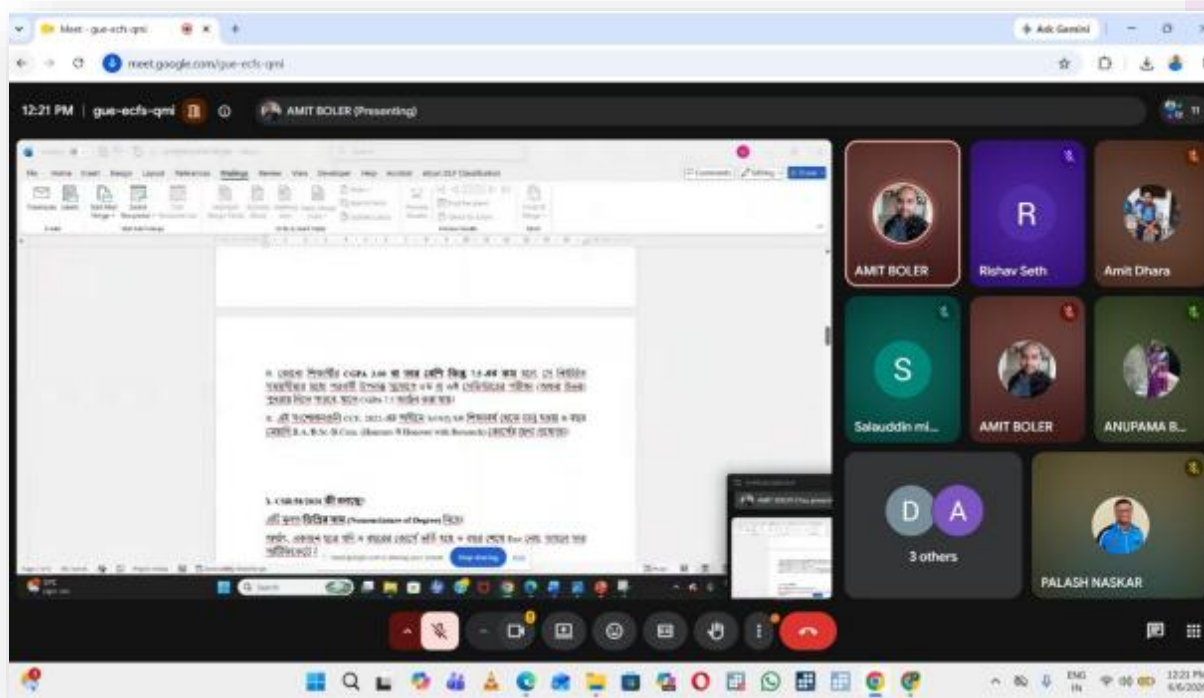
Transitioning to the Fourth Year an online Counselling Program

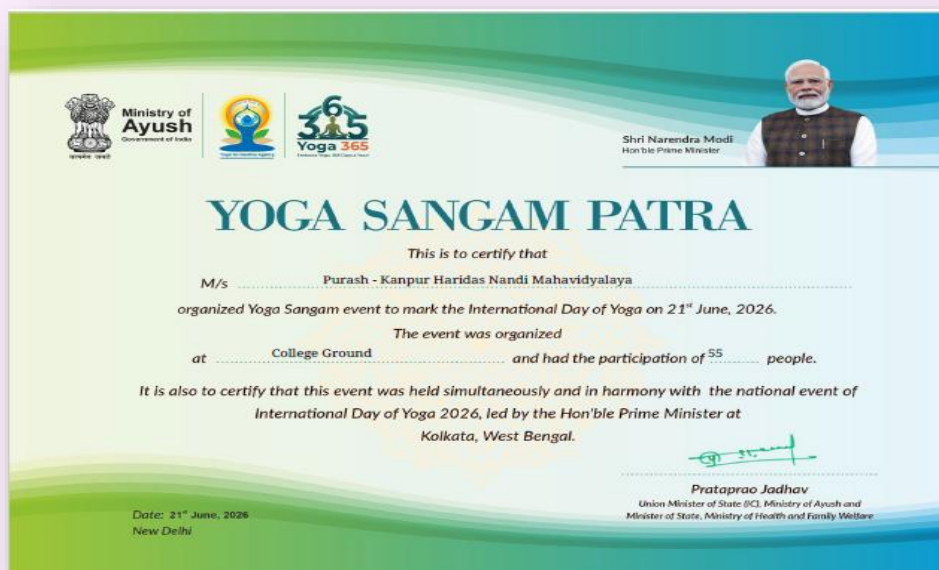
Unveiling of Online Student Magazine, “Unmochan”
